Sweden National	<b>4</b> <a href="#">Svenska Settlements förbundet</a>	Migrant integration /Active Citizenship	Community school  <b>Malmö</b> (near Copenhagen)	<b>3-7 May</b> *Tue-Sat	Model used in communities where more than 95 % are migrants and it reaches residents of all ages. The school organizes 15 different courses for free with weekly meetings targeting adults and especially women (70%) in each neighbourhood. Most of the 'educators' are volunteers among local inhabitants who can also suggest new courses according to target groups' needs. The model allows also for creating social bonds among local people. The Friday evening will be a celebration event at the community school; participants can help prepare for the event with the young people and the residents.
Denmark Local	<b>9</b> <a href="#">Askovfonden</a>	Social Inclusion /Active citizenship	KBH+ Project Academy  <b>Copenhagen</b>	<b>16 - 20 May</b> MON pm -FRI pm	A 5 months educational programme targeting local people aiming at developing projects and cultural events impacting the local community with the active participation of target groups, private sector and external partners. The project creates room for learning and experimenting by equipping beneficiaries with methods, tools, knowledge and by granting them the opportunity to create innovative local projects supported by mentors.
Finland National	<b>5</b> <a href="#">SUOMEN SETTEME NTILIIITTI ORY</a>	Social Inclusion	<b>Helsinki</b> + Hämeenlinna	<b>6 - 10 June</b> MON pm -FRI pm	Hima & Strada offers intriguing urban excursions designed and guided by people who have experienced homelessness. FFS has set up and coordinated a school for prisoners in Hämeenlinna. The idea is that during detention, prisoners receive educational support based on non - formal education and methodologies to develop soft skills and to set up their learning path to favour their reintegration into society and local community. Sopus Unit and Pro-Youth project focuses on tackling Honour-Related Violence in collaboration with the Police of Finland. NäytönPaikka -service(Make Your Life Visible) is a customer oriented and resource-based digital tool, which empowers and helps a person to reflect on their life comprehensively from different perspectives.

Through the project, several organizations proceeded in the development of a framework dealing with film as a pedagogical tool in adult education.. During the project funding period, the partners gained knowledge and developed skills (emotional, aesthetic and educational ones) in further developing non formal learning opportunities, namely film workshops with thematic orientation as a field of professionals searching for critical ways of thinking and social acting.

The inhabitants are benefiting from direct information about their social rights as Hungarian and European citizens and direct support concerning their social problems.

Some organisations focus on Asset Based Community Development as a means to allow people to focus on what they can do, rather than that which they can not. A community organisation who uses an asset to allow people to come together around using and develop skills in 'making', and potentially develop this into a small businesses. A collaborative of different organisations works on creating bottom-up democratic processes that allow people who historically do not get involved in local politics to come together to shape their own neighbourhood.
