IFS STAND for the International delegation.



IFS Stand and small meetings.

The Stand will be located on level 3 in "the Square" exhibition hall, from Friday morning. It will be a large area for informal meetings stood around high tables, brochures/handouts display, and our "headquarters". Please bring a coffee back from the refreshment point on level 3, and hangout.

The space behind the Stand is an "International Conference room" with 50 chairs. The IFS will have English-speaking workshops there, but at each break time between workshops during the Congress (Friday and Saturday), feel free to go round the back to sit down for a more formal conversation.

The stand will be taken down on Sunday morning, so we won't have access to it after Saturday evening.

Workshop rooms

We will also have 2 main workshop rooms for translated workshops: 3.4 and 3.5 which are very close to the IFS stand. They have interpreting cabins to the side.
